Commercial Electrician work environment:

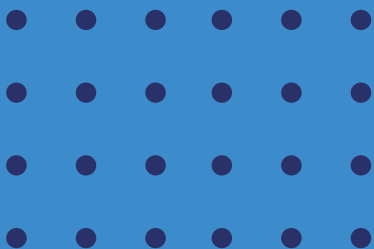
Construction sites & commercial sites
